Pine cones are rigid and spruce cones are soft and flexible.



A.E. Wilson Park has a hard to spot entrance at the corner of McCarthy Boulevard and 4th Avenue. There is lots of parking available.

The walkway is paved and the pathway on the island is dirt but usually accessible by stroller.

There is an approximately 30 minute loop and an approximately 1 hour loop to walk. For the 30 minute loop you need to cross the **top** of the bridge on McCarthy Boulevard. For the 1 hour loop you can go **under** the bridge at McCarthy Boulevard.
